

Council Meeting Minutes December 19, 2023

The Borough of Ben Avon Council met in a regular voting session on Tuesday, December 19, 2023, and at 7101 Church Avenue for the purpose of transacting General Business. Council President Rick Wagner opened the meeting at 7:00 PM with the Pledge of Allegiance.

# **BOROUGH REPORTS**

### Mayor's Report

Mayor Holcomb thanked the Avon Club for another successful house tour. She is also reviewing a handicapped parking permit request, and reviewing current handicapped spaces that may be no longer needed in the Borough.

### Ohio Township Police Report – See Attachment A

Chief Hanny reported 52 calls in December for the Borough. He noted that fraud complaints are on the uprise and reported that one victim was defrauded for over \$50,000. He stated that communication and education is key in avoiding fraud.

## Emsworth Volunteer Fire Company Report – See Attachment B

Chief Kohl reported 8 calls in Ben Avon this month. Mayor Holcomb thanked the Fire Company for the Santa stops in the Borough, and stated they are looking forward to next year's visit.

### Joint Planning Commission

Mr. Wagner stated Ms. Cieslak's term on the Commission will end December 2024. The three joint ordinances have gone through the public hearing and comment period and are up for vote this evening. There was a meeting of the Commission last week, and the minutes will be approved in January. Ms. Bett reported there is a new candidate for the representative from Ben Avon, Bruce Hall.

## Solicitor's Report

Mr. Pesillo reported that they prepared tonight's ordinance updating the noise allowances for the Borough. He also presented the addendum for the coffee shop lease for Council's review and vote this evening.

Statement of Revenue & Expense

Mr. Opipery reviewed the Revenue and Expense report and noted that the overall status was good and in line with last year's numbers.

## Accounts Payable Report

Mr. Opipery reviewed the AP Report with no expenses out of the ordinary.

### Ordinance 794 – 2024 Tax Rate

<u>Motion:</u> Mr. Opipery; <u>Second:</u> Mr. Thornton; <u>Motion Carried</u> by unanimous voice vote to adopt Ordinance 794 setting the formula for the 2024 tax rate.

## **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

<u>Administration Committee</u> – *no report*. Ms. Bett thanked Mr. Hall for volunteering to represent the Borough on the Joint Planning Commission.

#### Public Affairs & Communications – no report.

Ms. Bett stated the new website should go live after the first of the year.

### Public Safety

Mr. Wagner reported there was a recent meeting concerning the police services contract. There is some discussion required in Executive Session this evening, and stated there may be a vote on a contract in January if an agreement can be reached. He noted the costs remain high and increase each year. Mr. Opipery stated that the Council needs to consider the optimum service to sustain safe neighborhoods at the best cost.

### Public Works

Mr. Opipery commended the Public Works crew for their efforts this leaf season, and felt the Borough did a good job overall of communicating to the residents. Ohio River Boulevard continues to be a problem, with safe collection of leaves and all that would be required including permits, traffic control, etc. The council will continue to work for a solution for that specific area. The Public Works crew has now moved on to snow preparation and reports the dump truck needs repair. Ms. Roggenkamp asked about the status of the leaf loader following the discovery of a manufacturer defect, and Mr. Opipery stated it is in for repair.

### Community of Governments - See Attachment C

Ms. Washington stated that the Waste Management contract allows for an annual fuel cost adjustment, and there is no increase slated for the new year.

The Redevelopment Assistance Program is open, and the funding round closes on January 12, 2024. The Franchise Fee Cooperative discussed using Cohen Law Group to renegotiate upcoming franchise contract negotiations.

### **Sustainability**

Ms. Roggenkamp attended the meeting at the end of November. One item for Get Solar was the number of municipalities joint power purchase agreement to fund larger projects and allow

installation and then pay over time. She was not sure that was the optimum choice for Ben Avon but plans to learn more about the program. Ms. Roggenkamp stated that folks from Connect hope to attend an upcoming council meeting.

### Special Projects

### Centennial Building Committee

Mr. Wagner reported that Phase 1 was completed, with all but two windows replaced, and a new roof and insulation. The planning and design phase for the elevator project is underway and a team was in the building last week. There is a meeting scheduled on Thursday.

Executive Director's Report – December 2023

**2024** Fuel Cost Adjustment – Per the current waste and recycling contract specifications, participating QVCOG member municipalities will permit an annual diesel fuel cost adjustment for garbage and recyclable collection throughout the length of the contract. After conducting the specified calculation and confirming with the WM team, a calculation for the 2024 Fuel Cost Adjustment was conducted with **no increase** being slated for the new year. Please note, the following communities participate in the aforementioned agreement: Aleppo Township, Avalon Borough, Bellevue Borough, Ben Avon Borough, Edgeworth Borough, Emsworth Borough, Glen Osborne Borough, Glenfield Borough, Kilbuck Township, Leet Township, and Sewickley Borough.

**Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program** – The Redevelopment Assistance Capital Program (RACP) is a Commonwealth grant program administered by the Office of the Budget for the design, acquisition, and construction of a regional economic, cultural, civic, recreational, and historical improvement project. RACP projects are authorized in the Redevelopment Assistance section of a Capital Budget Itemization Act, have a regional or multi-jurisdictional impact, and generate substantial increases or maintain current levels of employment, tax revenues, or other measures of economic activity. RACP projects are state-funded projects that cannot obtain primary funding under other state programs. The RACP funding round will open Friday, December 8, 2023. The window will close Friday, January 12, 2024. More information regarding this funding opportunity can be found at <u>avcog.org</u>.

**Franchise Fee Cooperative** – In the recent past the Cohen Law Group has represented and worked on behalf of many QVCOG member communities when their franchise fee agreements were near expiration. A major advantage provided by this cooperative is reduced rates charged by the aforementioned firm. The current proposal as outlined commits a 20% discount if 7 or more QVCOG members participate. The proposal also includes a franchise fee audit to determine whether Comcast has paid each of the municipalities all the franchise fee revenue to which they may be entitled. Per the Cohen Law Group, between 2021-23, their firm conducted over 120 franchise fee audits (most of them of Comcast) and found underpayments approximately 65% of the time. Should an underpayment be identified during an audit, the franchise renewal is the best time to collect such underpayments (plus penalties and interest).
